

Log in to the Client Center using your TradeStation account credentials to launch the Futures+ web app, which supports the latest two versions of Internet Explorer and Chrome. After you launch the Futures+ platform, login. Or you can access Futures+ by logging in directly at <https://futuresplus.tradestation.com>.

1. Enter your Login ID and Password. (For new users, your login ID is the email address associated with your Futures+ account.)
2. Sign in.
3. Download the desktop app or select a product in the web app (see Page 3 for information on how to select a product).








